Dear Faculty Colleagues,

With the close of the spring semester, we would like to share another update with you on the status of the [core curriculum review](#), a process that began last fall and will continue into next academic year.

As noted in [its charge](#), the review committee has made consultation with faculty and students a key focus of its work so far. Many of you have submitted comments in writing or have participated in one or more of the conversations, forums, and meetings—both formal and informal—that took place this year.

We want to express our appreciation for your interest and involvement. The insights, questions, and ideas you have shared are all critical to deepening our understanding of Notre Dame's general education requirements and in shaping our conversations on how they might be improved.

The committee is planning to issue a draft report in fall 2015 based on its analysis of the ideas and feedback gathered. The campus community will then be invited to comment on the assessments and recommendations presented in that working document.
